

Role of the Regional Diversity & Inclusion Officer

The Regional Diversity & Inclusion Officer serves as a primary volunteer who is responsible for supporting educational growth and development of specific chapters within a given region pertaining to diversity and inclusion within the fraternity experience. This Officer will work with every chapter throughout each semester to assist with specific chapter incidents, as well as provide resources that will enhance the membership experience and provide un-invasive support to enhance the diversification of each chapter within Sigma Tau Gamma.

Regional Diversity & Inclusion Officer Expectations

Regional Officers will support chapters by:

- Work directly with all regional chapters to conduct an initial assessment of the chapter's demographics and operations to determine the level of diversity education and support.
- Develop and maintain relationships with campus departments and local community resources to provide free or low-cost programming to chapters within the region.
- Meet with each chapter's Diversity Coordinator or Director of Education & Wellness at least twice per semester to provide diversity support and resources.
- Ensure that all social behaviors align with the expectations that are given to the men in the chapter; in person and on social media.
- Attends regular monthly training opportunities hosted by Fraternity Staff.
- Review monthly CEO reports, SAGA Monthly, and SAGA Weekly to stay up to date with current updates from Headquarters and promote time-sensitive information within the region.
- Attends monthly Region Team meetings to assess the needs of the chapters within the region.
- Participates in Sigma Tau Gamma educational programming on a local and national level.
- Maintains strong verbal and written communication with the Regional Director to address chapter issues within a timely manner.
