

Role of the Regional Foundation Officer

The Sigma Tau Gamma Foundation exists to support the educational initiatives of the Fraternity and its chapters. The role of the Regional Foundation Officer serves as the primary resource for chapters seeking educational funding and scholarship opportunities, as well as providing additional opportunities for alumni to connect with undergraduates and other alumni, separate from their personal chapter connections.

Regional Foundation Officer Expectations

Regional Foundation Officers will support chapters by:

- Serves as the primary resource within the region for all inquiries related to the Sigma Tau Gamma Foundation and use of chapter funds or additional scholarship opportunities.
- Communicates with every chapter in the region at least once per semester regarding chapter fund balances and upcoming national programming opportunities.
- Maintains a firm knowledge of CrowdChange and ways that a chapter can use it for philanthropy and fundraising opportunities.
- Assists with communication to chapter alumni regarding chapter fundraising initiatives.
- Communicates monthly with Foundation Staff to provide updates and receive information pertinent to supporting chapters within the region.
- Review monthly CEO reports, SAGA Monthly, and SAGA Weekly to stay up to date with current updates from Headquarters and promote time-sensitive information within the region.
- Attends monthly Region Team meetings to assess the needs of the chapters within the region.
- Maintains strong verbal and written communication with the Regional Director to address chapter issues within a timely manner.
- Ensure that all social behaviors align with the expectations that are given to the men in the chapter; in person and on social media.
