

Role of the Regional Director

The Regional Director oversees a team of volunteers who are responsible for supporting the growth and development of chapters within a given region. The Regional Director, along with the Regional Officers, work with the Chapter Advisory Team and Headquarters Staff to provide guidance and support to alumni and undergraduates to observe the Principles and standards of Sigma Tau Gamma Fraternity.

Regional Director Expectations

Regional Directors will support the region by:

- Oversee the operation of a fully staffed Regional Team.
- Recruit alumni to serve as Regional Team officers in the event of a vacancy.
- Maintain relationships with alumni living in assigned region.
- At the direction of Headquarters Staff, interact with university professionals on a proactive and as needed basis to demonstrate support for chapters within the region.
- Host a monthly Regional Team meeting to address trends within the region.
- Participate in monthly Regional Director meetings with Headquarters Staff to learn new information and seek/offer guidance to better support the chapters of Sigma Tau Gamma.
- Maintain strong communication with Headquarters Staff to address chapter and/or regional issues within a timely manner.
- Participate in Sigma Tau Gamma educational programming on a local and national level.
- Review monthly communication to stay up to date with current information from Headquarters and promote time-sensitive information within the region.
- Work with Headquarters Staff to ensure every chapter in the region has a vetted and trained lead advisor.
- Work with lead advisors to recruit, train, and support a fully functioning Chapter Advisory Team for every chapter within the region.
- Work with Headquarters Staff to ensure all Regional Officers receive appropriate training and support, as needed.
- Attend alumni association events within the region, upon request and if available.
- Ensure that all of your social behaviors align with the expectations that are given to the men in the chapter; in person and on social media.
- Attend Webb Academy, annually.
