TIPS

- Don't make it about you.
- Be sure to listen more than you talk.
- Ask them what their level of comfort in sharing is so that you don't push too hard.
- Try not to give advice unless it's asked for.
- Ask the person what you can do to follow up or be more supportive as they process.
