Proposal No. 24.06

Proposed Amendments to the Laws to grant authority to the Board of Directors to correct any typographical, grammatical, or other non-substantial errors in the Laws and to re-number any sections as may be appropriate after the amendment process.

The Board of Directors is hereby granted the authority to make any non-substantial changes to the Laws solely for the purposes of (1) correcting typographical errors, (2) correcting grammatical errors, (3) correcting errors in punctuation, (4) correcting any other non-substantial errors in the text of the Laws, and (5) to re-number any sections as may be necessary after the amendment process.

Note on rationale for this legislation:

1. Minor errors are often created or identified by the amendment process, and sections often need to be renumbered after the amendment process. This provision gives the Board of Directors the explicit authority (which has been implied in the past) to make any such corrections without the necessity of sending the matter back to the House of Delegates.

This legislation was originally proposed by the Board of Directors.

Passage of this legislation requires an affirmative two-thirds vote of the House of Delegates.
