### 2026 – 2028 Term Position Openings

Five positions are open for election:

- Four Directors-at-Large (2 year term)
- One President (8 year term: 2 years as President-Elect, 2 years as President, 4 years as Past President)

### Eligibility

Candidates must:

- Be a Member in good standing with Sigma Tau Gamma
- Complete required governance orientation as specified by the Election Code
- Acknowledge and accept the obligations outlined in the Board Responsibilities and Declaration documents

### Application Deadline

Monday, March 16, 2026, by 11:59 p.m. EDT.\*

ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE DEADLINE IN ORDER FOR A CANDIDATE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR CERTIFICATION.

\*Pursuant to LAW XI, Section 3, should the number of eligible candidates filing for a position be the same or less than the number of seats open for the position then the filing deadline is automatically extended to Wednesday, April 15, 2026. If, after this extended deadline, the number of eligible candidates filing for a position remains the same or less than the number of open seats for the position, the filing deadline is automatically extended to Tuesday, June 16, 2026.

### Filing Declaration Submission Instructions

Your materials will be provided to delegates in advance of the Grand Conclave via “The Call.” The Call is an electronic document that call delegates to the Grand Conclave. It is distributed by email and our website.

The Filing Declaration form with all required supporting materials and video must be submitted by the stated deadline via email to [noblemen@sigttau.org](mailto:noblemen@sigttau.org). Submissions will be acknowledged within one business day. If an acknowledgement is not received, please contact Headquarters.

The application must include the following to be considered complete:

- A completed Candidate Filing Declaration Form (Revision: February 16, 2026)
- A professional photograph or headshot

- A video addressing the three questions outlined in the Declaration

## Video Requirements

The video provides delegates with the opportunity to see and hear your responses to the questions outlined in the Declaration. The intention is to showcase your genuine interest in Sig Tau; it is not meant to be a professional production.

Video requirements include:

- Begin with a brief introduction including your name, chapter or college/university, and initiation year. The introduction does not count towards your time limit.
- Address all three questions listed in the Declaration.
- The video should focus on your face. The use of presentations, placards, or campaign materials is prohibited. The intent is to capture your authentic responses.
- Excluding the introduction, the video must not exceed two (2) minutes. Videos that exceed the time limit will be truncated at two minutes.

Any video that includes inappropriate language or background material that is inconsistent with the Constitution, Laws, or Policies of the Fraternity, or with the values of a Noble Man, will not be posted at the discretion of the election commission.

Videos will be linked in the Call and accessible to anyone with the link; however, they will not be publicly searchable. The Nominations Committee will have access to all submitted videos, including those that are not posted.

## Grand Conclave

Candidates will receive election process details and participate in a mandatory candidate orientation conducted virtually prior to Grand Conclave.

Attendance at Grand Conclave Charlotte is encouraged but not required. Newly elected Directors are expected to attend the biennium's initial Board meeting on Sunday morning, June 28 and should not plan to depart the hotel before 12:00pm, noon, Sunday.

## Election Process

The election is conducted by the Election Commission in accordance with the Election Code, Constitution, and Laws of the Fraternity.

## Board of Directors Responsibilities, Obligations, and Expectations

Please reference the subsequent document titled "Board of Directors Responsibilities, Obligations and Expectations." It contains more detailed information regarding Board service and references relevant articles and sections of the Constitution and Laws and Board Policy Governance Manual. You will be asked to acknowledge that you understand and accept the obligations of Board service, and by signing and submitting the Filing Declaration, you will be deemed to have done so.
